



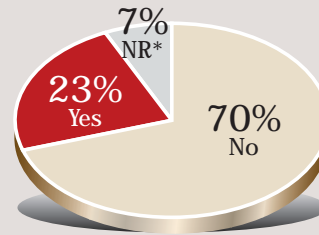
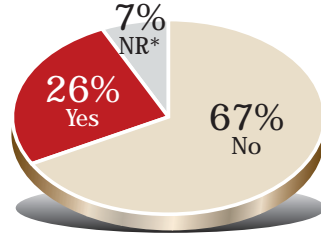
Freedom of information at public meetings

The survey conducted by the S.C. Press Assoc. found significant differences in views about closed school board and county council meetings.

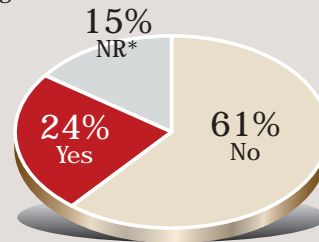
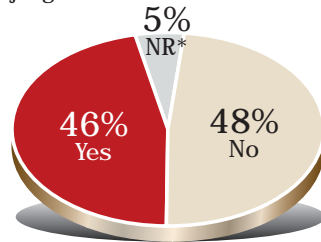

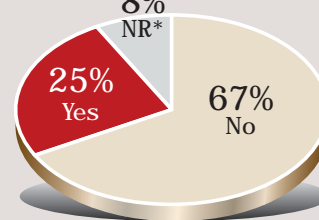
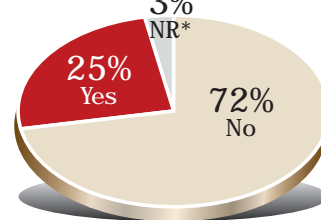
QUESTION: Have you ever participated in an executive session where a topic other than the one specified was discussed?



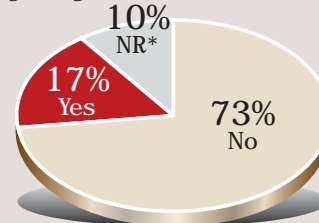
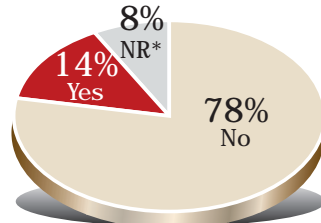
QUESTION: Would you object to the tape recording of an executive session if the tapes were only made available to a judge if that session was challenged?
